**Contest news coming at the April Pack Meeting!**

Our Recycling Program benefits animals injured by vehicles, loss of habitat and other calamities. The Scouts are rewarded with a thank you item at the end of the Scouting year but the animals are rewarded each day by having a safe place to live, recuperate, and otherwise grow and flourish, all thanks to the Pack 631 Recycling Program!

Back to Nature is a Wildlife Refuge that cares for wild animals that have been injured and for exotic animals that people have purchased and either abandoned or given up due to their care needs. Each critter that we adopt will cost us \$25. Help us adopt as many as we can and support Back to Nature, too!

Back to Nature will conduct tours of its facility for a donation of \$3 per person. Groups under 10 people can request a tour for a minimum donation of \$30. The Refuge is located 6 and a half miles east of Alafaya Trail on Highway 50. They can be reached at 407-568-5138 and also at [www.btn-wildlife.org](http://www.btn-wildlife.org).

While visiting Back to Nature, you might consider making a donation from their Wish List. Several of the items needed regularly are dry & canned dog food, dry & canned cat food, wild bird seed, cracked corn/10% sweet feed, clean used towels, sheets, blankets, and t-shirts, bleach and Dawn dish detergent, paper towels, gallon & sandwich-sized ziplock baggies, and trash bags of the 13-, 39-, 45-, and 55-gallon variety.

Bring your aluminum cans to your Den Meetings or the monthly Pack Meetings. Please attach your Scout's name on a piece of paper so they receive credit!
