

How can I help my Scout's den?

There are a number of ways you can help your Scout's den.
Check out the list below and see what's right for you.

Den Leader

The Den Leader runs the den meetings according to the Meeting Resource Guide, is at least 21 years of age and a registered leader.

Time Commitment - Two (2) Den Meetings monthly and attend one (1) monthly Den Leader Meeting.

Assistant Den Leader

The Assistant Den Leader assists the Den Leader in running the den meetings, is at least 18 years of age and a registered leader. They may also fill in for the Den Leader when unavailable.

Time Commitment - Two(2) Den Meetings monthly and attend one (1) monthly Den Leader Meeting.

Den Advancements

The Den Advancements person keeps track of the achievements and electives the Scouts complete and sends this information to the Pack Advancement Chair once a month.

Time Commitment - 15 minutes at each Den Meeting, 30 minutes monthly to compile awards and input into the provided form.

Copies

Copies occasionally need to be run for the Den meetings.

Time Commitment - as needed

Crafts

Crafts are a big part of the Scouting program. The Craft person gathers the necessary materials prior to the meeting and may be keeper of the Den Craft Box.

Time Commitment - varies according to meeting.

Den Dues Keeper

Den Dues keep the cost down for everyone. The Den Dues person collects and keeps track of the den dues at each meeting.

Time Commitment - 10 minutes at each Den Meeting

Den Outings Scheduler

Den Outings are included within the Scouting program to enhance the learning and experiences of our Scouts. Den Outings must be scheduled in advance of the den's arrival.

Time Commitment - 20 minutes per outing (typically a den has three or four outings)

Snack Scheduler

The Snack Scheduler gets commitments from parents prior to the den meetings, collects allergy information and informs den parents, and may send reminders.

Time Commitment - 15 minutes at first Scout meeting of the year to determine schedule/allergies.
